



How to get there:

Travel to Kanazawa is easy by plane, by train and by car. The Shiinoki Cultural Complex (Pre-workshop) is located close to Kanazawa Station of JR and can be reached by direct airport bus from Komatsu Airport. The bus stop near downtown hotels is KORINBO (香林坊) stop.

By air

You can fly from airports located at Tokyo, Fukuoka, Shanghai, Seoul and Taipei to Komatsu airport directly.

By bus

If you arrive at Tokyo and Osaka, then you can take highway bus to Kanazawa Station.

By train

If you arrive at Osaka and Nagoya, you can take express intercity train to Kanazawa station.

Conference bus service

SPSD2011 Conference will be held in Kanazawa University, you can take a bus from KORINBO (香林坊) stop to Kanazawa University(金沢大学自然科学研究棟). A free conference bus (Charter Bus) will pick you up near your hotels at the downtown of Kanazawa city to Kanazawa University, however the time schedule of our free conference bus is limited. Please check detailed information in SPSD bus timetable carefully.

Meanwhile, we also ask Bus Company to add some route buses for SPSD and you can pay with coins in a bus (JP¥350) for taking those route buses by yourselves. Please note that you need to take a number (bus stop number) in the bus door when you enter a bus.




Notes

"Musashi" Bus Stop








Sightseeing Map (Enlarged area)


